BHUTAN

As of date, there are ZERO COVID cases in the country, with 867 recovered and unfortunate 01 death in first week of January according to latest health ministry figures.

Bhutan is going to start the COVID vaccinations from 27th March as they have received the first consignment of 0.15 million dosages of COVID-19 vaccine from India. Bhutan is the first country to receive the Government of India's gift of the COVID vaccines, manufactured by the Serum Institute of India (SII).

According to our resources, post Vaccination the travel restrictions will relax specifically the mandatory quarantine period of 21 days. The authorities are hoping to welcome tourists from third quarter (Jul-Sep) which is dependent upon completion of immunization.
