

Coronavirus Update

Date – 26th June 2020

BHUTAN

Bhutan has successfully managed to control the number of cases as they closed the borders just in time to restrict all international arrivals to its territory. The coronavirus case count in Bhutan now stands at 70 cases, with 34 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. The good part is that there's no evidence of community transmission and no death is reported due to the virus so far. Government has decided to reopen its economy in phased manner, initiated to open sports entities like football fields, golf club, basketball courts for locals to engage in them. Curfew for opening and closing of shops, restaurants & bars/pubs has been extended to 9 pm from 01st July onwards. Schools will also reopen starting 01st July. Inter-city borders are open for locals & International Borders still remain closed until further notice.
