

Coronavirus Update

Date – 17th November 2020

BHUTAN

Bhutan has successfully managed to control the number of cases as they followed strict lockdown rules. The coronavirus case count in Bhutan now stands at 377 cases, with 355 recovered, according to latest health ministry figures.

The good part is that there is no evidence of community transmission and no death is reported due to the virus so far.

Bhutan is operating limited flights over Air Bubble agreements with India and Thailand.

The arrangement allows operations of flights with these two countries (India & Bhutan) under restrictive conditions like maintaining mandatory 21 days quarantine for all travelers upon arrival in Bhutan.
