

Coronavirus Update

Date – 23rd July 2020

INDIA

The coronavirus case count in India now stands at 12,38,635 (*as per latest update this Thursday*) cases, with 7,82,606 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 29861 deaths are reported due to the virus. However, recovery rate is at an all-time high at 63.18% and death rate is at 2.5%. A cumulative total of 1,50,75,369 samples have been tested so far. With aggressive testing, timely diagnosis and effective management of patients either through efficient medical attention in hospitals or supervised home isolation is thought to have led to a rise in recovered cases.

Domestic flights have already begun its operations in a calibrated manner and restarting of normal scheduled international passenger flights has now been deferred further until 31 July. Educational Institutes / schools and international air travel is expected to follow in upcoming phases depending upon assessment of the situation.
