

Coronavirus Update

Date – 26th June 2020

INDIA

India has begun to re-open its economy in a phased manner nearly after two months. The coronavirus case count in India now stands at 473,105 cases, with 271,696 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 14,894 people have died due to the virus.

With cities and districts being designated as green, amber and red zones depending on the scale of infection – restrictions are being eased gradually as people return to work. Lockdown restrictions would only be imposed in containment zones, while activities would be permitted in other zones in a phased manner. This first phase of reopening is termed as "Unlock 1 and permitted shopping malls, religious places, hotels and restaurants to reopen from 8th June. Large gatherings are still banned, but there would be no restrictions on inter-state travel. However, night curfews would be in effect from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. in all areas and state governments would be allowed to put suitable restrictions on all activities.

Domestic flights have begun its operations in a calibrated manner and International flights yet to be operational. Educational Institutes / schools and international air travel is expected to follow in upcoming phases depending upon assessment of the situation.
