

India Update over Covid Scenario

Date – 3rd June 2021

INDIA

The Covid-19 situation in India has improved over the past few days. The country has been reporting below 2,00,000 new coronavirus cases daily for the past seven days, compared to over 4,00,000 new Covid-19 cases during the April end. The positivity rate has also been falling and deaths too. Even some of the states (Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir) have also started the process of unlocking as the Covid-19 situation improves in their states.

On Wednesday, India crossed the landmark milestone of administering 220 million cumulative vaccine doses.

Government Officials on Friday announced that it would be able to vaccinate all against COVID-19 virus by the end of December 2021 and Health Ministry gave roadmap for producing 2160 Million doses by then.

Another batch of 30,00,000 Sputnik V vaccine doses have arrived in India and are being moved to 7 locations. WHO has named the Covid-19 variants first detected in India as Delta and Kappa. The WHO's move came nearly three weeks after India objected to the B.1.617 mutant of the novel coronavirus being termed an "Indian Variant"

Cipla is in talks with US pharma major Moderna to bring its single-dose vaccine to India with an advance of \$1 billion.
