

Coronavirus Update

Date – 27th October 2021

NEPAL

Nepal's coronavirus caseload reached 810,298 on Wednesday with 582 more people testing positive for the infection in the past 24 hours.

Nepal's vaccination is proceeding at a rapid speed; to date, 6.49 million people have been fully vaccinated thus far. In anticipation for a probable third wave, Nepal is beefing up its healthcare system and stockpiling vaccines (if it happens).

Fully vaccinated clients can travel to Kathmandu without any quarantine restrictions. For the convenience of travelers, VISA on arrival has been reinstated. All tourist attractions are open for fully vaccinated guests.
