NEPAL

Owing to the possible increase in the number of cases in Nepal, Government has requested not to hold any kind of meetings, processions, rally, gatherings, seminar, and any kind of businesses inviting a large number of people and follow social distancing, continue use of masks, wash hands frequently and follow the protocols.

Many districts in Nepal have imposed lockdown, for Kathmandu valley lockdown started from 29th April 2021 has now been extended till 12th May 2021 with no vehicular movement except for the essential services.

Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal on 3rd May 2021 has released the below notification regarding the international flight operation.

- a) All schedule and passenger charter flights, except flights between Nepal and India under air bubble arrangement, have been suspended from 6th May 2021 midnight (23:59 Nepalese Standard Time) to 14th May 2021 midnight (23:59 Nepalese Standard Time).
- b) There shall be only two flights a week (one flight each by Nepal Airlines and Air India) under Air Travel Bubble Arrangement between Nepal and India with effective from 6th May 2021 midnight to 14th May 2021 midnight Alt F, Tower B, Suncity Success Tower, Sector 65, Golf Course Extension Road, Gurugram, Haryana, 122018 | www.distinctdestinations.in | info@distinctdestinations.in



subject to following conditions:

- Arriving passengers shall undergo mandatory quarantine at their own costs for 10 days in hotels enlisted by Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Civil Aviation.
- Person violating quarantine provision as stated above shall be penalized in accordance with the Infectious Disease Act, 2020 (1964, CE)
- Airline found boarded any PCR Positive Passenger shall be liable to bear the cost of hotel quarantine of all passengers onboard in the aircraft.
- Passengers are required to furnish PCR Report with photo identification and barcode while arriving at Tribhuvan International Airport, Kathmandu.
