

Coronavirus Update

Date –22nd March 2021

NEPAL

The coronavirus case count in Nepal now stands at 275750 cases, with 1001 infected cases, 271733 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 3016 deaths are reported due to the virus so far.

All tourist visas have been restored, and foreign visitors are now free to fly into the country for Culture, Leisure, trekking and hiking expeditions.

The Government has decided to ease entry protocols to visit Nepal. Tourists already Vaccinated or having negative PCR reports (72 Hrs. prior to arrival day) will be exempted from quarantine restriction. Government has also decided to resume on arrival visa in Nepal like pre-covid scenario.

Nepal has joined hands with India for air bubble arrangement. Air India and Nepal Airlines are now permitted to operate flights between Delhi and Kathmandu.
