

Coronavirus Update

Date - 03rd June 2021

NEPAL

Although the number of infections has decreased in Nepal in recent days, the country continues to face numerous obstacles, as daily infections remain high. In May, the Himalayan country recorded 8,000-9,000 cases on most days before seeing a drop in the final few days after the pandemic's second wave began in early April.

Since May 26, the daily figure has dropped below 7,000 instances, with 5285 infections recorded on June 1.

Many districts in Nepal have imposed strict lockdown, for Kathmandu valley lockdown started from 29th April 2021 has now been extended till 3rd June 2021 with no vehicular movement except for the essential services.

The corona virus case count in Nepal now stands as follows according to latest health ministry figures.
