

Coronavirus Update

SRI LANKA

The country has reported an all-time high case of coronavirus infection for the seventh consecutive day. Much like India, the number of individuals confirming positive for COVID-19 is increasing day by day. The count for the last 24 hours is 1000+ new patients.

Sri Lanka's health authorities have issued new strict guidelines, including banning wedding receptions and gatherings at religious sites, to prevent the spread of the coronavirus as the Island nation continued to record a spike in daily infections.

Sri Lanka has put a cap on the number of air passengers that are allowed to come into the country. The Civil Aviation Authority of Sri Lanka said that the authorities have taken the decision to reduce the number of passengers to 75 for a flight.

Certain areas in the island are on strict lockdown. No public gatherings at all and very strict rules have been imposed by the government. Spas, Swimming Pools, & clubs inside the country are closed. Pubs & Bars in hotels are permitted to be open within a certain time of the day.
