

Coronavirus Update

Date – 21st September 2021

SRI LANKA

The Sri Lankan Government imposed an island-wide quarantine curfew until the 01st of October. Covid mortality and infections have reduced during the lockdown period. Sri Lanka's vaccination is proceeding at a rapid speed; to date, 11 million plus people have been vaccinated thus far.

Schools remain closed and have adopted online education to teach students.

Interprovincial travels between the provinces are restricted for local people except for essential services & foreign travelers. Colombo airport is in operation at this stage with strict measures in place. Travel restrictions for foreign travelers have been eased out and fully vaccinated clients may go out of the bio bubble after a 24-hour quarantine stay. All tourist attractions are open for fully vaccinated guests. The vaccination program is going successful & by October end most of the population will be fully vaccinated.

Sri Lanka now allow the entry of vaccinated tourist from India to revive their travel industry and there is boom expected from Indian travelers in last quarter of 2021.
