

Coronavirus Update

Date – 15th September 2020

INDIA

The spread of the novel coronavirus in India has quickened in the last few days with new cases of Covid-19 and deaths reported every day. The epidemic has expanded its footprint in the country and has affected 49,30,236 as on date.

India's coronavirus recovery rate soared past 78.28 per cent today, taking the total recoveries to 38,59,399 people. The fatality rate has dropped further to 1.64 per cent, resulting 80,776 deaths as of today.

The new 'Unlock 4.0' guidelines has been announced wherein Metro services are operational in graded manner and Academic/ sports/ Social/ entertainment/cultural/ religious/ political functions are permissible with a ceiling of 100 people at maximum. Schools can reopen for Classes 9 to 12 from 21st Sep on voluntary basis.

Cinema halls, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres (excluding open air theatre) and similar places will continue to remain shut until 30th September 2020 & Situation will be reviewed again thereafter. International air travel (outbound) is also not allowed.

The world heritage monuments Taj Mahal and the Agra Fort will reopen from 21st September. The two monuments have been closed since March 17 due to the nationwide lockdown which was instituted to curb the spread of the coronavirus disease.
